Dear Parents and Employees,

Please be advised that the Bloomfield School District will not be opening into the hybrid model on September 8th. Due to notification of additional requirements specified on September 3, 2020 by the Public Education Department (PED), in the attached required Toolkit, the District is unable to meet the added requirements for Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for students and staff.

Please know that we really want to teach students in person and hope to be able to start the hybrid model at a later date. Safety is our priority and we need time to acquire the additional PPE such as N95 mask, gloves, gowns and face shields. One additional requirement is that everyone will have to wear a face mask, or face shields with an additional face mask under the shield. Previous guidance did not require this.

We will continue with remote learning at home for now. Once all requirements are met, we will advance to the hybrid learning model with the option for students to remain learning remotely if they so choose.
