**Superintendent Dr. Kimberly Mizell, Statement of School Reentry:  
Bloomfield School District Target Date to Open in Voluntary Hybrid February 16<sup>th</sup>  
pending School Board Approval on February 9, 2021**

Bloomfield School District has set a target date of February 16, 2021 to open the secondary schools into a voluntary hybrid model. Our reentry plans have been approved by the New Mexico Department of Education and we are waiting on the final inspection within the next two weeks. All protocols and health requirements have been in place since September.

Parents will continue to have the option to remain in remote learning or to allow students to return to school in the hybrid model. The model consists of the same A/B schedules for students being utilized by our elementary schools.

Bloomfield School District is committed to doing all it can to facilitate the vaccination of all staff who want it when it becomes available to Phase 1B in the NMDOH prioritization for vaccination.

On February 3, at 6:00 p.m. the District will conduct an information session for the community to understand what the hybrid learning environment will look like in BHS, Mesa Alta and CYB. Please join us for the sharing of information.
